### **Re: Year 6 GTBG In Class Behaviour System**

I'm reaching out to share an exciting new initiative we're introducing in our classroom to encourage and celebrate positive behaviour. My aim is to create an environment where each student feels motivated, supported and rewarded for making good choices every day. This new system will work alongside our whole-school Good To Be Green behaviour policy, with a special focus on encouraging and recognising the positive behaviours that help our classroom community thrive.

### **How the System Works**

- **Weekly Reward:** Each Friday, children who have consistently demonstrated positive behaviour by staying on green all week will have the chance to participate in a special reward activity. These may include fun projects, helping younger children or engaging in creative activities—options that celebrate and reinforce their commitment to making good choices.
- **Reflection for Growth:** Children whose behaviour choices have contributed to them not remaining Green in that week, will join me in a brief reflection activity on Fridays. During this time, they'll complete "Reflection Activities" to consider their actions, understand their impact and set a goal for improvement. This approach supports personal accountability and growth in a constructive way.

### **How You Can Support at Home**

Please encourage your child by asking them about the choices they made each day and celebrating the good things they did to contribute to our classroom. For children who do engage in a Reflection, we ask that you review it together, offering support as they work toward their goal for the following week.
