- ▶ Edit and improve their writing independently

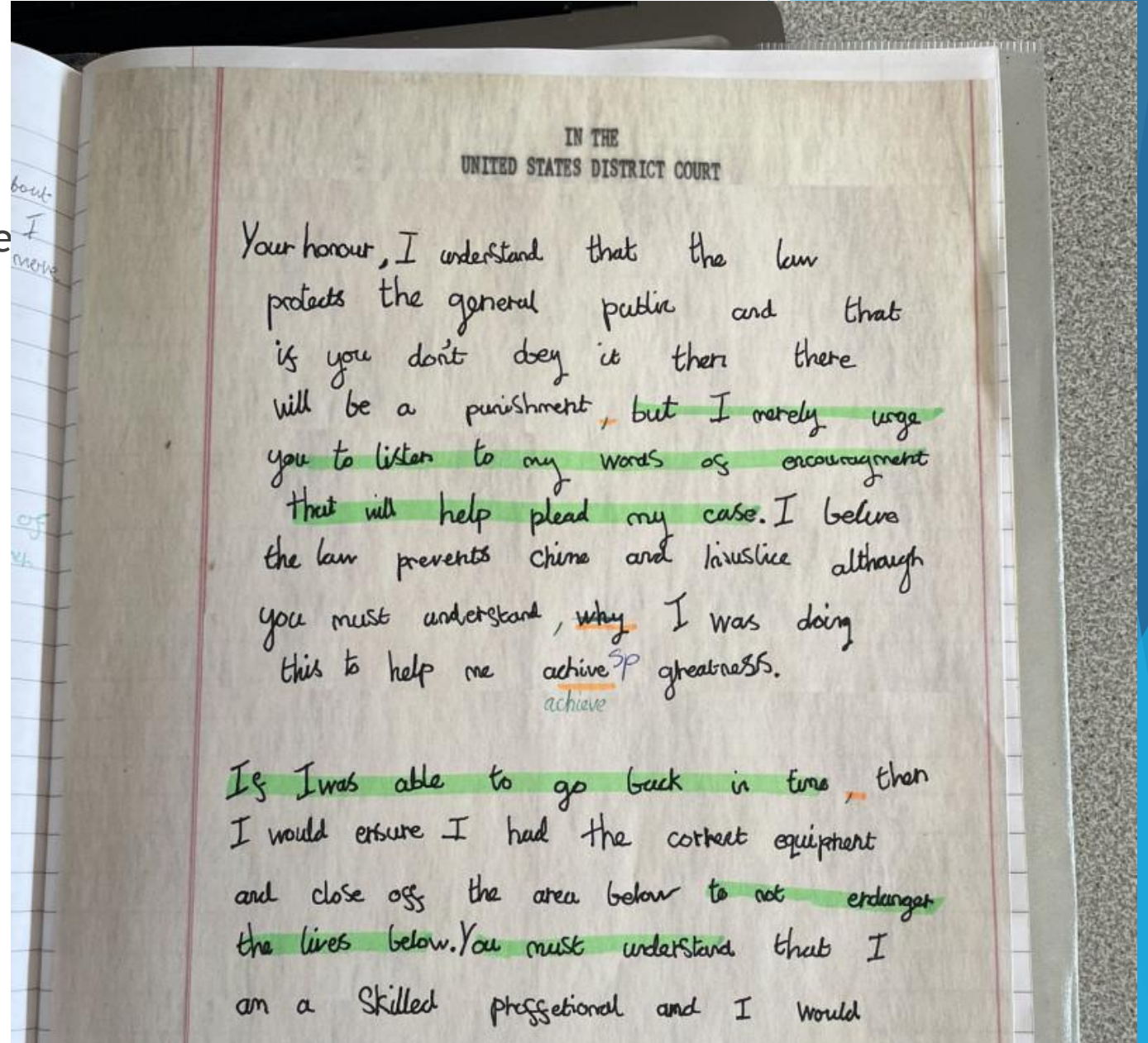
Ways to support Literacy at home:

Maths - Year 5 expectations

We will learn to:

- Read, write and order numbers to 1,000,000 in numerals and words.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally up to 5 digits
- Know all times tables and use standard written methods to solve multiplication and division problems
- Add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions
- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute.
- Solve one and two step problems using information presented in charts.

PE Kits

- PE is on and **Tuesday and Friday** for Year 5. Children should come into school wearing their kit.
- Correct kit consists of navy blue or black shorts and a navy blue top. In winter, children may wear tracksuit bottoms, comfortable trainers and their school jumper.

- No big labels!

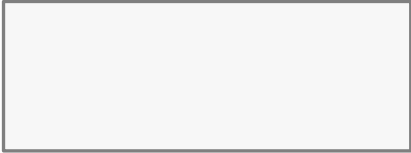
School uniform
